


Casting Call

CINDERELLA

CHARACTER BREAKDOWNS:

Please note that all performers will multirole.

Cinderella:

(Female identifying, playing age early 20s, singer)

A kind-hearted young modern woman with a big heart and infectious generosity of spirit. Although she is bullied on the daily, Cinderella is strong willed, has big dreams, and truly believes that good nature will get her a happily ever after, whatever that is.

Sour Bake Stepma:

(Female identifying, playing age early 30s+, singer)

Cinderella's selfish, cruel, and vain stepmother, the villain of the show. Confident rapport with the audience important, larger than life skills in whipping them into a frenzy required. Concerned with status she wants nothing more than for one of her daughters to marry into wealth and will stop at nothing to get it.

Sidekick Sista's:

(Any gender, any playing age)

Like their mother, **Sour Bake Stepma**, Cinderella's soulless stepsisters the **Sidekick Sista's** are vain, vile, and selfish. Desiring nothing more than to marry rich and continue their life in the lap of luxury, ready to take down anyone who gets in their way. Not so bright and deliciously devilish, we love to laugh at these pair.

N.B It is increasingly likely that this character may become 1 performer across both sisters. Puppetry skills welcome here.

Buttons/Prince (multirole):

(Male identifying, playing age early 20-30s, singer. Multirole)

Buttons Cinderella's best friend is her cheerful, quick-witted loyal sidekick. He may quietly pine after Cinderella but really just wants her to be happy. A comedic and light entertainment touch with this character who develops a good rapport with the audience. Physically entertaining, with skills in circus or at least confident with movement and possibly tricks would be beneficial.

Prince is kind and longs to meet his true love. He wants to marry someone who loves him for who he is instead of his status. Full of heroic bravado but deeply naïve and not always quick on the draw. In search of his purpose. His kind-hearted nature spills into an endearing goofiness at times. Light comedic touch essential.

Fairy Godmother (Dame):

(Any gender, any playing age, singer)

A friendly fairy with magical powers, who helps Cinderella find her happily ever after. Responsible for Cinderella's incredible transformation, desiring everyone to achieve their version of a happy ending, again, whatever that may be. Warm with a spark of wackiness, quirky and endearing, this character lifts the magic in the show.
